Security and Access to Event Premises

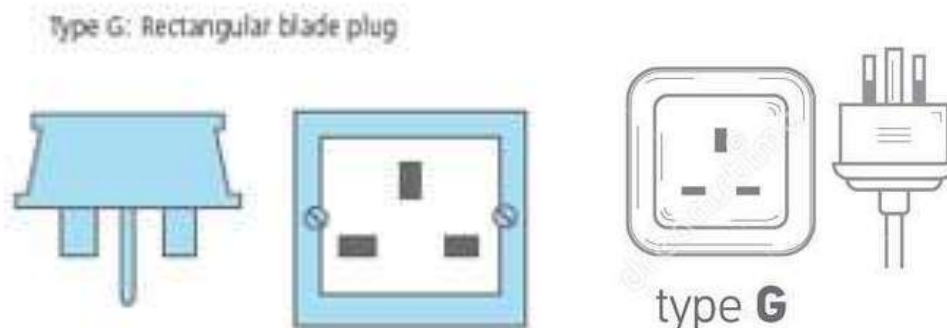
